We are a studio that brings traditional French know-how to the 21st Century through innovation.






THE ORIGIN OF YMER&MALTA

- I came from the world of cinéma
- I create a scenario for each piece
- For our first piece we mixed dovetail assembly, african headrests and japanese stools.




THE BONE STOOL


- And we created the Bone Stool using marble and oak wood.













THE TRADITIONAL FRENCH KNOW- HOW

- Marble made in a very light and thin way
- Wood marquetry made with contemporary design and varnish adapted to the day-to-day use
- Aubusson Tapestry made in 3D exploring the interpretation of textures and materials



INSPIRED BY NATURE

YMER&MALTA creations are often inspired by natural elements: rock textures, animals, trees, water drops, lichen, clouds and so on...

- In the left slide, the forest i saw reflected in a lake on a trip to Sri-Lanka.
- On the right, the inspiration of snowy field realised in Aubusson Tapestry.




PAYSAGE POLAIRE

PAYSAGE POLAIRE - MOODBOARD

- I created a moodboard to give the weaver references.
- I translated this inspiration into a frozen landscape for The Aubusson Tapestry collection.



PAYSAGE POLAIRE - SAMPLES

- We created many, many samples to interpret the different textures of snow. This was quite unusual in the Aubusson Tapestry world, because interpreting textures was something new in this know-how.




THE ARTISANS

- I worked closely with the artisans.
- This allowed me to push the limits of their know-how.




PAYSAGE POLAIRE - NEW KNOTS

- -The tapestry is in relief wich is very unusual.
- -Through this process we innovated the traditional know-how by creating new weaving knots



PAYSAGE POLAIRE - FINAL PIECE

- The Cité Internationale de la Tapisserie considers this piece revolutionary in the history of Aubusson Tapestry, which is a UNESCO intangible heritage.



FALLENTREE - PRODUCTION

- -I was inspired by a drawing
- -The artisan proposed the best assemblage.
- -we chose the most beautiful oak tree branches.
- -The foot of the base was done with the very new technique in industrial optical glass and machined wood.



FALLENTREE: AN ICONIC PIECE

-This iconic piece has been acquired by 3 prestigious institutions.

In total YMER&MALTA has created

- -100 pieces
- -63 exhibited
- -25 purchased



EIDOS XXI FOR THE MOBILIER NATIONAL

- I proposed an ensemble piece which at this time was new for them.
- -Using "savoir-faire" that we already worked with.




VERNISSAGE AT THE MOBLIER NATIONAL

- At this time, Madame Macron fell in love with this ensemble and requested it for the Elysées Palace.




AKARI UNFOLDED

- "Belle de jour" inspired by the cliffs of Corsica.




THE GREAT LADY COLLECTION

- Burned wood was the inspiration for this piece.
- -Half is actual burned wood / Half tapestry interpreting burned wood.




SAVOIR-FAIRE AND INNOVATION

- I was awarded the "Chevalier des Arts et des Lettres" by the French Minister of culture in recognition for my work in innovating traditional materials and "savoir-faire."




AUBUSSON TAPESTRY: THE GREAT LADY

- -"The Ours" cabinet in Bog Oak, that has been under water for 5.000 years.




AKARI UNFOLDED for The Noguchi Museum

-Work with 25 artisans to make the collection.




SLEEPING BEAUTY: MARQUETERY REVISITED
